## **The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

- 1 Title**  
This Act is the Policing (Involvement in Local Authority Elections) Amendment Act 2010.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**  
This Act amends the Policing Act 2008.

**4 Police involvement in elections**

- (1) Section 99(1) is amended by omitting “or a member of a local authority”.
- (2) Section 99(1)(b) is amended by omitting “or subsections (2) to (4) of this section”.
- (3) Section 99(2) to (4) are repealed.

**5 Section 115 repealed**

Section 115 is repealed.
