Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Amendment Regulations 2010.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 April 2010.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Regulations 2004.
- 4 Schedule amended to increase rates**
Each provision of the Schedule of the principal regulations listed in the first column of the Schedule of these regulations is amended by omitting the amount set out opposite to it in the second column and substituting in each case the amount set out opposite to it in the third column.
- 5 Consequential revocation**
The Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Amendment Regulations 2009 (SR 2009/26) are consequentially revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2010, amend the Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Regulations 2004.

The amendments increase rates of childcare and OSCAR (out-of-school care and recreation) subsidies available to certain caregivers with dependent children.

These increases reflect a 1.96% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index (All Groups) from the December 2008 quarter to the December 2009 quarter.
