Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2010.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 April 2010.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Regulations 2005.
- 4 Schedule 2 amended**
Each provision of Schedule 2 of the principal regulations listed in the first column of the Schedule of these regulations is amended by omitting the amount set out opposite to it in the second column and substituting the amount set out opposite to it in the third column.
- 5 Consequential revocation**
The Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2009 (SR 2009/23) are consequentially revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2010, amend Schedule 2 of the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Regulations 2005.

The amendments increase the limits on certain allowable costs for which temporary additional support may be granted.

The increase in the amount in clause 3(a) reflects a 1.03% increase in the actual rentals for the housing component of the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2008 quarter to the December 2009 quarter. The other increases reflect a 1.96% increase

in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index (All Groups) from the
December 2008 quarter to the December 2009 quarter.
