## Regulations

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Land Transport (Certification and Other Fees) Amendment Regulations 2010.
- 2 Commencement**  
These regulations come into force on 1 April 2010.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**  
These regulations amend the Land Transport (Certification and Other Fees) Regulations 1999.
- 4 New regulation 8C inserted**  
The following regulation is inserted after regulation 8B:  
**“8C Fee payable for Category A Left-hand Drive Vehicle Permit application**  
The fee payable for a Category A Left-hand Drive Vehicle Permit application under clause 1 of Part 2 of the Schedule of Land Transport Rule: Steering Systems 2001 is \$150.”

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2010, amend the Land Transport (Certification and Other Fees) Regulations 1999. The amendment specifies a fee of \$150 for a Category A Left-hand Drive Vehicle Permit application under clause 1 of Part 2 of the Schedule of Land Transport Rule: Steering Systems 2001.
