Pursuant to sections 115 and 116 of the Dairy Industry Restructuring Act 2001, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Dairy Industry Restructuring (Raw Milk) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2010.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 June 2010.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Dairy Industry Restructuring (Raw Milk) Regulations 2001.

4 Interpretation

- (1) Regulation 3(1) is amended by revoking the definitions of **dis-tribution** and **new co-op retention**.
- (2) The definition of **kilograms of milksolids** in regulation 3(1) is amended by omitting “in that capacity”.
- (3) The definition of **total cost of milk** in regulation 3(1) is amended by—
 - (a) revoking paragraph (a)(iii); and
 - (b) inserting “raw” before “milk” in paragraph (a)(iv); and
 - (c) revoking paragraph (b)(i) and (ii).

5 Obligations to publish information

- (1) Regulation 16(1)(b) and (4)(d) and (h) are revoked.
- (2) Regulation 16(4)(g) is amended by omitting “season; and” and substituting “season.”
- (3) Regulation 16(6) is amended by omitting “(c) to (h)”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations refine the definition of total cost of milk. Fonterra uses the total cost of milk to determine how much independent processors have to pay Fonterra for raw milk it supplies to them.

The regulations also remove unnecessary publication requirements.

The regulations come into force on 1 June 2010.
