## Regulations

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Wine Amendment Regulations 2010.
- 2 Commencement**  
These regulations come into force on 1 July 2010.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**  
These regulations amend the Wine Regulations 2006.
- 4 Schedule amended**  
The Schedule is amended by omitting the item relating to standards setting; development of guidance material, templates, codes of practice, market access standards; systems audit and compliance, and substituting the item set out in the Schedule of these regulations.
- 5 Revocation**  
Regulation 5 of the Wine Amendment Regulations 2009 is revoked.
