### 1 Title

This order is the Misuse of Drugs (Presumption of Supply—Ketamine) Order Commencement Order 2010.

### 2 Commencement of Misuse of Drugs (Presumption of Supply—Ketamine) Order 2009

The Misuse of Drugs (Presumption of Supply—Ketamine) Order 2009 comes into force on 1 December 2010.

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings the Misuse of Drugs (Presumption of Supply—Ketamine) Order 2009 into force on 1 December 2010.

That order adds ketamine (2-(2-chlorophenyl)-2-(methylamino)-cyclohexanone), which is to be classified as a Class C controlled drug, to Schedule 5 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 and specifies 10 grams as the amount at and over which ketamine is presumed to be for supply.

Section 4A(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 provides that, before this commencement order is made, the Misuse of Drugs (Presumption of Supply—Ketamine) Order 2009 must be approved by resolution of the House of Representatives. The House of Representatives approved that order on 4 May 2010.
