- 1 Title**
This order is the Customs Import Prohibition (Toothfish) Amendment Order 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
This order comes into force on 10 May 2012.
- 3 Principal order**
This order amends the Customs Import Prohibition (Toothfish) Order 2009 (the **principal order**).
- 4 Clause 3 amended (Expiry)**
In clause 3, replace “10 May 2012” with “10 May 2015”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 10 May 2012, amends the Customs Import Prohibition (Toothfish) Order 2009 so that it expires on the close of 10 May 2015. The effect of this order is to extend for a further 3 years the prohibition on the importation of Antarctic toothfish and Patagonian toothfish.

Under section 54(5)(a) of the Customs and Excise Act 1996, this order expires on the close of 31 December 2012 except so far as it is expressly confirmed by Act of Parliament passed before that date. If confirmed in that way, this order expires on the close of 10 May 2015.
