5.3 The Assignor has not knowingly withheld from the Assignee knowledge of any circumstance that may cause the Registrar of Trade Marks to object to the registration of the Trade Mark.

5.4 The Assignor will keep the Assignee indemnified against all actions, claims, proceedings, costs and damages (including any damages or compensation paid by the Assignee on the advice of its legal advisors to compromise or settle any claim) and all legal costs or other expenses arising out of any breach of the above warranties or out of any claim by a third party based on any facts which if substantiated would constitute such a breach.

3 Assignor's obligations

- (a) The Assignor agrees to execute all documents that are, or may be, required to vest complete rights, title and interest in [optional: the Registered Trade Marks and] the Trade Mark Applications in favour of the Assignee, [including/excluding] the goodwill of the Business.
- (b) The Assignor agrees to do all acts that may be reasonably necessary to:
